VORPAL made the front heading on to the main course and was left alone to dictate the early pace, held a clear led into the stretch then responded when set down and drew away to the wire. MCCLUSKY settled mid-pack, then ran on late to gain second. SUGAR BUZZ hustled to get forward position, settled inside behind the pacesetter, chased to the stretch then weakened a bit and was passed for the place. RUN BRYCE RUN was last going into the far turn, then made a wide move around that turn, came into the stretch with good momentum and improved. DEKUDYLAN settled at the back early, saved ground, made a mild bid on the inside through the far turn, but had trouble changing leads in the stretch and faltered. FIVE TWENTY SUNSET was never a threat. LIMITED HEATWAVE raced two or three off the rail through the early stages, then was outkicked in the stretch.
