DEPARTURE settled outside of rivals in the early stages, was coaxed along while widest into the turn, mounted a six wide rally to upper stretch and closed determinedly into the final furlong, wore down foes in deep stretch and was up in time to prevail. DIAMOND RIM got crowded at the start and broke a step slowly, settled off of the solid early pace while never far back, tracked two wide and between foes into the turn, angled three wide to upper stretch and responded into the drive, vied for the lead between rivals in deep stretch and just missed for the win, while getting up to earn the place honors. SAWASDEE broke alertly and assumed early command, set a solid pace up the backstretch then showed the way into the turn while off of the rail, moved to the inside into upper stretch and held sway to the furlong pole, was caught by the oncoming top pair in deep stretch and held safely in the end for third. MR. WHO broke out at the start and bothered an outer rival to begin, was last away from the gate then rushed up along the inside, chased from the inside to the quarter pole, tipped to the two path to upper stretch, got caught in tight and checked inside of the furlong marker and was outkicked in deep stretch. CHUCKANUT BAY was unhurried in the early going, trailed to the turn then lacked room at the quarter marker, angled widest at the furlong marker, found his best stride late but could not reel in the leaders in deep stretch. MINER LEAGUE settled in the second flight early on and tracked outside of rivals along the backstretch, chased the pacesetter four then three wide into the turn, bid to upper stretch, was outkicked at the furlong marker then drifted out a path inside of that station, could not find more late and weakened in the final sixteenth. TERRY'S BOY was forwardly placed in the early running, chased the pace three wide into the turn, ran in pursuit four wide into upper stretch, lacked the needed response at mid-stretch and did not rally late. POWERIZED was close up to the early pace while inside of rivals, stalked the solid pace while saving ground into the turn, ran in pursuit of SAWASDEE into upper stretch then gave way in the final stages. THERE WAS A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN OF THIS RACE. THE STEWARDS DETERMINED THAT MINER LEAGUE IMPEDED MR. WHO PAST MID-STRETCH BUT AS MR. WHO FINISHED AHEAD OF MINER LEAGUE, NO ACTION WOULD BE TAKEN.
