CHAMAVILLE, taken to rate while saving ground entering the backstretch, angled out near the half then edged up, went on the attack three deep near the five sixteenths, forged to command into the lane, spurted clear under a drive past the three sixteenths then held firm denying SUNGLASSES (GB). SUNGLASSES (GB) settled off the early pace while saving ground, took closer order into the far turn, was stalled behind the embattled leaders mid way on the final turn, worked outward to be four wide entering the lane, gave willing chase while on her left lead but was unable to make serious inroads in the final seventy yards. CLASSY stalked off the inside, moved up three wide to have aim leaving the far turn, shifted out five wide in upper stretch, shifted back in with pursuit in mid stretch then churned on. FALL MOON drafted back off the pace, cmae our wide for the drive, briefly paused near mid stretch then finished with interest between foes. GOLD COAST GIRL broke slowly, dropped in soon after and settled off the pace, saved ground into and through the lane, advanced to the inside of rivals and kept on trying. RIBBONS AND LACE sped clear early, set the pace towards the inside, was joined nearing the far turn, dueled inside rivals past the five sixteenths then weakened in the final furlong. BUILT DIFFERENT stumbled at the break, regrouped and settled three wide, moved up into the far turn, swung out five wide from behind rivals entering the stretch, shifted back in a bit near mid stretch then flattened out under some mild hand encouragement. FAST TO FORTUNE stalked the pace, bid two wide outside the leader past the half, sparred between foes past the five sixteenths, failed to kick on leaving the three sixteenths then steadied when fading past mid stretch.
