ONES ON THE WAY broke in a bit at the start and crowded inner rivals, sent for the early lead, assumed command and set the pace to the turn, drew clear along the bend and dictated terms to the quarter marker while in hand, drew off into the stretch and was ridden out to win as much the best. RIGHT AND TIGHT was hard to load prior to the start, broke alertly and stalked the early pace, ran in pursuit of ONES ON THE WAY into the turn, was no match for the winner into the stretch, stayed on into the final sixteenth and was best of the rest. BOUJEE BRITCHES settled off of the early pace, tracked outside of rivals approaching the turn, chased four then three wide nearing the quarter pole, lacked a final response in the stretch drive but kept on into the final sixteenth and was a clear third. SALTY SISS rated just off of the early pace and tracked between rivals along the backstretch, chased two wide then from the rail nearing the quarter pole, could not find the needed response in upper stretch and weakened in the drive. OBSESSED WITH YOU got crowded by an outer rival at the start and was off slowly, settled along the backstretch run, chased three wide and between foes into the turn, lacked the needed response at the quarter pole and did not threaten the leaders late. I'M LYING settled outside of rivals along the backstretch run, tucked in into the turn and trailed three wide nearing the quarter pole, lacked the needed response to upper stretch and did not factor late. TURPIN MEADOW was crowded at the start and off a step slowly, tracked the early pace from inside of rivals, was caught in tight approaching the turn and took up at the three-eighths, got shuffled back and lost position nearing the quarter marker, swung out to upper stretch and lacked a further response.

MINI AGAIN was forwardly placed away from the start, contested the early pace inside of SWEET BETH, held a narrow lead into the turn, set a moderate pace while off of the rail nearing the quarter pole, shook free into the stretch, kept to task under steady late handling and proved best in deep stretch. PRIME NUMBER broke in and bumped an inner rival at the start, settled off of the early pace while saving ground, angled out and chased two to three wide to the quarter marker, shifted back to the inside into upper stretch, rallied along the rail into the final sixteenth, was kept at bay in deep stretch and held safely for second. CIRCLE OF FIRE settled in the second flight and tracked outside of rivals in the early stages, was well placed while four wide into the turn, came within aim of the lead nearing the furlong marker, was outkicked to the final sixteenth and held safely for third. MISTY MALIBU was forwardly placed away from the start, rated off of the early pace and tracked between rivals along the backstretch, chased two then three wide and between foes into the turn, ran in pursuit of the leaders to upper stretch, shifted four then five wide for the stretch drive and finished evenly. SWEET BETH showed speed leaving the start and contested the early pace from outside of rivals, disputed the pace two to three wide into the turn, pressed the pace to the quarter pole then was outkicked to upper stretch, battled into the final furlong then weakened in the final sixteenth. COUGAR JEWEL bobbled at the start but was away in good order, tracked the early pace from between foes, chased two wide to the quarter pole, ran in pursuit between rivals into the stretch, could not sustain her run to the final sixteenth and flattened out late. BANDERSNATCH was allowed to settle in the early stages, saved ground nearing the quarter marker, chased from the inside into upper stretch and could not muster the needed late response. POCKET KNIFE settled while saving ground in the early going, maintained an inside path to the quarter pole, saved all of the ground to upper stretch, could not find the needed response at the furlong marker and weakened late. RECYCLEYOURHEART got squeezed at the start and was last away from the gate, raced erratically while outside of rivals along the backstretch run, continued to be hard to place entering the turn, was eased through the stretch drive and was transported off of the course via the equine ambulance.

BIG STETSON raced close up to the early pace, pressed three deep to the turn then dueled to the quarter pole, shook free of MISTER O into upper stretch, drew away into the final furlong and was ridden out as much the best. IM GUNNA allowed to settle in the early running, saved ground into the turn then got caught a bit in tight nearing the quarter marker, shifted two wide for the stretch drive and rallied into the final furlong, was no match for the winner in the late stages but was clear in the end for the place. CLASSIC ALPHIE got bumped at the start and was off a bit slowly, allowed to settle in the early running, coaxed outside of foes into the turn, swung widest to upper stretch and closed for third in the late stages. TOWHEE broke in and bumped inner rival at the

start, was well placed in the early stages, tracked between foes into the turn then chased from the inside nearing the quarter pole, gained ground into the stretch, could not sustain that run to the final sixteenth and flattened out late. HUGH GLASS broke awkwardly and was off a bit slowly, tracked the early pace from outside of rivals, lost ground while three to four wide nearing the quarter pole, stayed on into the stretch and passed tiring rivals in the late stages. BARKLEY'S IMAGE broke awkwardly and was off a bit slowly, settled off of the early pace while not far back, coaxed two then three wide nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide to upper stretch, needed more in the final stages and finished evenly. LORD ANTHEM tracked the early pace from the second flight, was well placed to the turn and chased three wide nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit into upper stretch, could not find more into the final furlong and weakened late. UH OH EL TRAVADOR got crowded at the start and was away a bit slowly, lacked early speed and trailed into the turn, saved ground to upper stretch and did not factor late. MISTER O broke in at the start and crowded inner rival, showed good early speed and contested the pace from the inside along the backstretch, dueled inside of BIG STETSON into the turn, disputed a solid pace to the quarter marker then was repelled into upper stretch, could not find more into the final furlong and gave way. SUAVE VRON was away in good order and pressed the early pace from between rivals, contested the pace to the turn then got shuffled back nearing the three-eighths, chased the dueling leaders to the quarter pole, lacked the needed response into upper stretch and tired in the drive.
