OLYMPIC LEGEND , bounced around between runners leaving the gate, recovered and accelerated between rivals to join the pace fray, vied three deep nearing the turn then was nicely rated dueling outside RACER REX around the turn, responded when given his cue soon into the lane, forged clear under a drive near the furlong grounds, shifted in a bit and powered away while kept to task. SNAP COUNT , well back off of the contested pace, gathered momentum past the five sixteenths, advanced inside a quartet of rivals in mid stretch and kept on with good energy to gain the place. RACER REX was sent up early and gained a slim lead vying inside foes into the turn, emerged ins a duel inside the winner leaving the far turn, battled with that one to about mid stretch, shifted out and gave way grudgingly. HAIL STATE chased two to three wide and outside a foe exiting the far turn, was stalled near mid stretch, shifted in and kept on with interest. ROLL DEM BONES had speed then drafted back off the embattled leaders, chased four to five wide into the lane but failed to muster up a serious run. TAINO HOUSE saved ground, eased out three wide for the drive, chased between horses in mid stretch then lacked a bid.

SAINT PIO drifted out at the break, raced off the pace, came four wide for the drive and failed to respond. BEER BEGONE , pushed outward at the break and bumped with the outer winner, sparred between horses early, chased around the turn and weakened. GROOVY HUEY , off the pace, raced six wide in upper stretch and failed to menace. WEDNESDAY AT SHADY , acting up as the gates sprung, dwelt, found himself well back in the opening sixteenth, saved some ground into the stretch but failed to get involved.
