CRUSHER ROYALE was rated back off foes in the opening furlong then tracked under a light hold, took closer order of a contested pace entering the far turn, angled out past the five sixteenths and circled four wide into the lane, closed steadily under pressure, forged past MONEY LINE inside the sixteenth pole, switched over to his left lead and went clear. MONEYLINE pulled his way clear entering the first turn and dropped in to set a rated pace, handled outer pressure from DJOSER from the half mile pole to the five sixteenths, spurted away after being set down in upper stretch, kept on under a drive past the furlong grounds, dug in when confronted by the winner then gave way stubbornly. MY VINO settled off the pace while saving ground, remained inside for the drive, moved up a bit past mid stretch and churned on. DJOSER sped clear early then was rated back off the leader into the first turn, angled out and rebid near the half, pressed the quarter pole, failed to go on past the three sixteenths and faded. RATLEFF broke inward then steadied when keen off a rival's heels in the opening eighth, regrouped and settled in the clear, chased three wide into the far turn and failed to ramp up a rally. THE MAN THE MYTH dropped well off the early pace, raced two to three wide in upper stretch and failed to generate a run.
