SAL GAL took a hard bump from HIDDEN TIGER after the start then was at the back of the field with a lot of lengths to make up, saved all the ground through the turn then angled out to the three path for the stretch run, responded to steady handling and intermittent urging found best stride inside the final sixteenth and was along in time. DIVINE GIFT was briefly with the early leaders then dropped back, was kept in a drive from the start, angled out three wide for the stretch run, found a second wind in the final furlong, had the lead in sight of the wire, but could not hold off the winner. HIDDEN TIGER ducked in at the start and made hard contact with SAL GAL, started to advance three wide heading into the turn, came five wide into the stretch and produced a good rally under steady handling but too late. ROCKSIE HARTBRAKER hustled away well then dueled inside of LUCKY LARA to the stretch, pulled ahead slightly racing on the left lead, dug in gamely but weakened and could not hold off the top pair in the final yards. LUCKY LARA showed good speed from the outside post and engaged ROCKSIE HARTBRAKER in a speed duel to the stretch, had every chance to get by that rival in the stretch but was rebuffed, then weakened late and was passed for a minor award just yards from the finish line. SING A HAPPY SONG broke well and made the lead without being coaxed, went clear passing the three furlong pole, held the margin into the stretch, was confronted by BLESSED ANGEL inside the furlong pole, had no response but was able to save the place. FAST GISELLE vied between horses early, then struggled to keep up with less than three furlongs to run, tried to rebid from three wide into the stretch but was only able to maintain position to the wire. DADS ESTRELLA raced outside of TWELVE STARS in the second flight, well behind the pace battle up front, launched a three wide bid on the turn and into the stretch, finished with some interest but was much too late. TWELVE STARS unable to keep pace after the break, saved ground and tried to rally late but was not good enough. GO GO SADIE devoid of speed, dropped behind early, was gaining late along with the other two trailers but was unable to improve. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

ELEGANT BOY broke well and was forwardly placed without being asked, tracked three wide under a snug hold through the early stages, was let loose after passing the half, then put into a stiff drive from the five-sixteenths, did battle with HEAT N REHEAT in the stretch, gained the advantage inside the furlong grounds and won clear. HEAT N REHEAT broke well then took over the pacesetting duties after passing the six furlong marker, was left alone to carve out the early fractions, battled back when confronted by ELEGANT BOY at the quarter pole, kept on gamely to deep stretch the gave way grudgingly in the final yards. KEEN HEIR went three wide through the first turn then settled at the rear of the tracking group, was coaxed to go forward after passing the half-mile pole, advanced four wide through the turn, flattened out some in the stretch while on the left lead but was kept to task, finished well to earn the third spot and was well clear of the next horse. KYSTONE got good inside position from the break, tracked mid-pack through the early stages while saving ground throughout, launched a mild bid from the quarter pole into the stretch but could not sustain the bid. RONAMO got caught five wide into the clubhouse turn, advanced to be up with the early leaders while racing four to five wide down the backstretch, launched a bid after passing the seven-sixteenths pole, loomed at the top of the stretch but flattened out. NICE GUY EDDIE was hustled to get forward position and gained the inside and the lead through the first turn, ceded the lead to HEAT N REHEAT as the field turned down the backstretch, began to struggle to keep up after passing the half then faded the rest of the trip. RAILWAY raced near the rear of the field through the early going, was put into a drive from the seven-sixteenths pole but did not respond and was not presevered with in the late stages. AFFABLE MONARCH was not asked for speed from the break but pulled through the first turn, came off the bit as the field headed down the backstretch, was

FREEZE 'EM veered out very wide after the start then attended the early pace from the outside, made an early move toward the lead after passing the half-mile marker, bid three wide and took a short lead at the head of the stretch, did battle with a stubborn foe to the inside but finished well under a strong hand ride to prevail. J C'S A LEGEND hustled from the break and vied inside for the early lead, took over the lead at the half-mile pole, tried to push back when FREEZE 'EM bid near the quarter pole, kept on well under steady handling but was unable to vanquish the winner. JUSTIN AZTECA broke well and was sent to the front, quickly confronted by foes to the inside and outside, ceded the lead passing the half but continued to stalk the pace, was unable to quicken with the top pair into the stretch but chased with vigor, cut into the margin approaching the wire, but came up short. SALSATION hustled then settled inside behind the pace battle not far away, launched a bid leaving the three furlong pole but could not go on with the top three in the stretch, kept to task and managed to finish best of the rest. MONGOLIAN SPRING broke a step slow then got shuffled back shortly after the start when J C'S A LEGEND took the path, settled at the rear through the early stages then launched a five wide bid on the turn, finished willingly but for too late to make any impact. DEKUDYLAN was last through the early going then picked off some rivals with mild late interest in the stretch. OBSIDIAN GOLD tracked in the middle of the pack to the turn, came under a ride from the quarter pole but did not respond and finished evenly in the stretch. MANDELA EFFECT devoid of speed, raced
