ENOS SLAUGHTER was prominently placed while racing three-wide, took the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and edged clear late. SILVER DASH set the pace racing two-wide under pressure from ANNA'S IRON MAN, opened a clear lead nearing the quarter pole, responded when headed nearing the sixteenth pole and continued on gamely to the wire. HADLEES HONOR saved ground while being reserved off the pace, slipped through during the drive and finished in a mild rally. ANNA'S IRON MAN prompted the pace racing along the inside and weakened slightly during the drive. OUTOFQUEMADO was allowed to settle, moved up three-wide nearing the quarter pole and then went evenly late. MOESAHANDFUL was five-wide on the fire turn, moved up four-wide to offer a bid nearing the quarter pole and then flattened out during the drive. RIDIN SOLO was forwardly placed early racing two-wide and tired. NAVAL ESCORT raced in the back of the field, rallied three-wide into the stretch but was unable to seriously threaten. CLIFF DIVER was unhurried early, moved forward nearing the quarter pole but failed to be a factor. BENDETTIJOE raced five-wide and gave way.
