CESTRAND vied for the lead three to two wide, remained in the three path turning for home, took over entering the lane and drew off. LOTSA STEEL chased along the inside, split foes two wide in midstretch and forged place at the sixteenth pole. SHANGHAI BARBIE reared at the start and broke multiple lengths slow, raced off of the pace in the five to three path, progressed four wide and between rivals in midstretch and ran on. ANNAMARIA stalked the top pair from the four path, chased while getting floated to the five path at the quarter pole then gave way. KAELY'S CANDY vied for the lead along the inside, sparred with the eventual winner around the turn, proved no match for that one entering the lane, yielded place at the sixteenth pole and faded. SNEAKY SITUATION prompted between the top pair before backing off to stalk approaching the turn, tipped out to the four path at the quarter pole, chased three wide leaving upper stretch then faded between horses. PRANCING MATILDA veered outwardly and spotted the rest multiple lengths at the start, trailed in the two path and made little impact.
