POCO YO bumped with an inner rival at the start, led in the two path, built a clear advantage into the turn then drew off under a mild drive. LORD ANTHEM bumped with an outer rival at the start, settled off of the pace along the inside, steadied behind a pair foes reaching teh lane, split those rivals at the furlong grounds and ran on to reel in place in the shadow of the wire. SMILE DONT WINK bumped with an inner foe at the start, stalked in the four path, pursued closest to the clear leader around the turn, but proved no match for that one before yielding place to an inner rival late. FIRST ELDAAFIRST raced close up in the three path and between horses, gave way around the turn yet kept on mildly through the final furlong. SUAVE VRON chased forwardly along the inside and yielded. WHY NOT MAYZEE was bumped between rivals at the start, lacked speed in the five to six path and failed to factor. TRYDENT bumped with an outer foe at the start, tracked from midpack in the four to five path into the lane and tired. MISCHIEF IN LISBON took firm contact simultaneously from rivals on both sides at the start, trailed early on, hit the inner rail and lost action approaching the turn, lost contact with the rest shortly after, pulled up nearing the lane and was transported off of the track in an equine ambulance.
