

JOE DON LOONEY broke on top then was joined to the inside by RUGGS and NOLONGERAHOBBY, contested the pace three wide, went on with the latter from the three furlong marker, cleared off from the rest in the stretch, got the better of the rival in mid-stretch and proved best under intermittent urging. RUGGS broke out at the start then was hustled to the front and was the inside horse of a trio contesting the early lead, turned into the stretch with JOE DON LOONEY and battled through the stretch under steady handling and urging, then gave way grudgingly inside the furlong grounds and saved the place. ULTIMATE tracked behind the pace battle to the turn cornered three wide under a drive and finished with some interest but unable to threat the top pair. TIGER TOO steadied just after the start when RUGGS took the path, spotted the rest a couple of lengths head start, raced at the back well behind the rest with BEER MONEY matching pace to the outside, was kept to task and was gaining in the end. SMUGGLER'S RUN broke well but was content to let the pace scenario play out up front, was coaxed forward through the turn then loomed four wide at the top of the stretch, went flat and was unable to threaten late. BEER MONEY lacked speed and raced at the back of the pack, went into a drive before the three furlong pole then three to four wide into the stretch and flattened. NOLONGERAHOBBY vied between horses in a three-way battle for the early lead, was first to back out leaving the three furlong pole then had little to offer in the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

SWAMPDRAINER settled early then advanced readily leaving the first turn, stayed in the clear then quickened when given the cue with about three furlongs to run, came up to the leaders at the top of the stretch, had some trouble with the lead change and was put to stiff left handed urging, drifted out inside the furlong pole into the path of FLINT STROLL and held on. FLINT STROLL was off slowly, then raced in the clear three to four wide, was put into a sustained drive after passing the half-mile marker, went three wide through the far turn the swung five wide into the stretch, was finishing well under left handed urging, steadied near the sixteenth pole when SWAMPDRAINER came into the path twice and had to settle for the place. ROSENQUIST got away well and tracked close up through the early stages, became boxed in through the far turn, found some room late in the stretch, surged under urging but came up short. MANGIA PANE was allowed to settle from the break and saved ground under a pretty tight hold, bided time down the backstretch, then lacked room to make a move on the turn, was loaded turning into the start but was blocked, altered course to the four path, finally got clear and made a late move but was too late. MOESAHANDFUL was hustled from the start but was caught three wide exiting the chute then ranged up to put pressure on UNUSUAL WIN down the backstretch while appearing to be traveling well, was set down at the top of the stretch but did not quicken and went one-paced to the wire. UNUSUAL WIN broke well then led the field through the first turn, got some pressure from MOESAHANDFUL down the backstretch but was still able to dictate a reasonable pace, dug in under threat turning into the stretch but was unable to sustain the bid and gave way. PHOENICIAN GHOST broke well and was forwardly placed through the initial bend, then dropped off the pace and was last going down the backstretch, was coaxed along to no avail and chased the rest of the way.

BODI ZAFA broke out at the start, then was allowed to settle, raced between horses in the second flight down the backstretch then moved forwardly when cued approaching the three furlong pole, bid three wide past the quarter pole into the stretch and finished well under steady handling despite racing on the left lead and won clear. JUST TRUST ME was always close up but content to stalk at the pace set by the early leader, went to challenge for the lead after passing the three furlong marker, gained the lead in mid-stretch but could not match the winner late. BITTERLY settled on the rail and tracked mid-pack, moved to challenge for the lead on the far turn, came under a drive but had the path blocked at the top of the stretch, kept to task to gain third but could not threat the top pair. WELCOMETOHOLLYWOOD had good early speed and vied for the lead through the first turn, turned onto the backstretch in front with several in close attendance, but was left to dictate the pace, led to the far turn then tried to step up the pace, dug in under a threat into the stretch but tired. STRIKING NOTES unhurried from the break and last into the first turn, trailed while being rated at the back of the pack, made a mild late run on the last turn but was only able to pass a couple of tired ones while finishing well behind the rest. BUTTERMAKER raced with close up with the tracking group through the early stages, started to fall behind approaching the quarter pole then tired in the stretch. DESERT BREEZE bobbled after the break then recovered and raced up close to the pace four wide through the first turn, then was three deep with the second flight down the backstretch, dropped out near the half-mile marker and was outrun the rest of the way and not persevered with when hopelessly behind.

PACO'S PICO unhurried from the break, advanced in tandem with STAR ENTRY late down the backstretch and through the turn, loomed four wide into the stretch then angled to the insidefor clear running, accelerated nicely through an opening between horses and just held off that same foe at the wire. STAR ENTRY settled at the rear to the outside of PACO'S PICO and matched strides with that one from the start to the top of the stretch, tipped to the outside for the stretch run while the rival went to the inside, finished up well but could not get to the wire in time. BEDROCK settled mid-pack then started to run on





under a drive from the three furlong pole, came three wide into the stretch and finished willingly but was outkicked in the final yards. NEW EVERY MORNING sent forward from the outside, gained the lead before the turn but was joined by KHAIKY'S COMMAND through that turn, battled gamely but was outoinished int he shadow of the wire. VICENTE'S SHADOW lagged well behind the field to the stretch, was kept to task and was gaining some in the late stages. KHAIKY'S COMMAND hustled from the break, pressed the pace from the inside through the turn, took a short lead at the top of the stretch, battled gamely then gave way in the final yards. OUR BOLD PRINCE veered in towards the gap after the break, then was unable to keep pace early, chased inside then lacked a rally. SQUARE DEAL away well, raced in mid-pack to the top of the lane then finished one-paced in the stretch and was passed by all but one in the stretch. GONNA GETCHA GOOD broke on top but was overtaken by NEW EVERY MORNING before a furlong, remained close up through the turn then weakened in the stretch.
