ATMOSPHERIC RIVER was mid pack early on, racing along the outside, then rallied around the far turn, dueling for the lead down the lane and held on for the win with a driving finish. RATLEFF had no early speed away from the gates, racing on the outside near the back, then closed around the turn, dueling for the lead in the stretch and just missed. RESULTANT was allowed to settle, racing on the outside, then circled the field in the far turn, dueling for the lead down the lane and held third with a blanket finish. GOLDEN GREEK was mid field early on, racing along the rail, then offered a bid in early stretch, dueling for the lead, but got edged at the wire. DRIVE TRAIN had no early foot leaving the gates, on the inside with a mild late run. NO ORDINARY TIGER pressed the pace early on from the outside, the gained a brief lead in the backstretch but gave way at the head of the lane. FRISCO stalked the early pace down the backstretch but flattened out down the lane. TOPPERS AT SEASIDE made the early lead, dueling down the backstretch and faded in the far turn.
