BABE'S GOT APPEAL showed good early speed from between runners, set the pace to the turn, cleared to the rail midway through the bend, kept to task into the stretch and held sway in the late stages. RESERVOIR crowded by an outer neighbor at the start and a step slow to begin, chased the early pace from between rivals, shifted to the rail and ran in pursuit to the quarter pole, could not impact the winner into the drive, made a mild late bid and held well in deep stretch for the place. DON'T TELL HYDEE chased the early pace from outside of runners, ran in pursuit three to four wide into the turn, lacked the needed response into the stretch drive and was outfinished late for the place honors. BOHEMIAN JIGGLES bobbled then crowded at the start and away a bit slowly, chased from the inside to the stretch and offered a mild late rally. PALACE STAR broke in a tangle and was off slowly, settled in the early stages, swung widest into the stretch and was never a factor. OLIVIAN pressed the early pace from the inside, raced a bit in tight while saving ground to the turn, shifted to the two path and chased to the quarter marker, could not keep pace into the stretch and tired in the final furlong.

TRIPLE PASS allowed to settle early on while never far back, raced a bit in tight while between runners nearing the quarter marker, angled five wide for the stretch drive, sustained his rally to the final sixteenth, surged in the final strides and just missed for the win, while besting the rest. GIANNO prominent early, pressed the pace between rivals to the turn then dueled HIT SCENE to the quarter pole, battled into the stretch and held a narrow lead at the furlong marker, met the bid of DAGGER RANCH into the final sixteenth then was outfinished in deep stretch, while holding in the end for third. HIT SCENE showed good early speed from the inside, set a contested pace to the turn then dueled GIANNO to the quarter marker, battled into the stretch then stayed on into the final furlong, could not find the needed late response and yielded in the final sixteenth. COPPER COASTLINE close up to the early pace, chased three wide to the turn, well placed nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit to mid-stretch and weakened in the late stages. IT'S TURBO tracked the early pace four wide and between runners, got shuffled back at the three-eighths marker then ran in pursuit from the inside into the stretch, lacked the early pace three wide and between runners, got shuffled back the three-eighths marker then ran in pursuit from the inside into the stretch, lacked the needed response in the drive and did not factor late. WHO IS PAVEL bumped then squeezed at the start and off a bit slowly, recovered to track the early pace from the inside, saved ground to the quarter marker, tipped two wide into the lane then tired.

MY VINO tracked the early pace five wide to the turn, improved position at the quarter marker, made a wide rally into the stretch then altered course behind a drifting rival nearing mid-stretch, responded to urging and sustained his run to the final sixteenth, surged in the final strides and was up in time for a determined win. ROCKNTHECLUBHOUSE tracked the early pace four wide to the turn, was well placed nearing the quarter marker, chased three wide into upper stretch, dove inside at the furlong marker then took command into the final sixteenth, dug in while leading in deep stretch and was tagged in the final strides for the win, while holding for second. TERRY'S SERVICE stalked the early pace while saving ground to the turn, pressed the pace to the quarter marker then took command into the stretch, led to the furlong ground then was overtaken into the final sixteenth, stubbornly stayed on in deep stretch and was outfinished by the top pair, while holding for the show. NO ORDINARY TIGER hustled to be forwardly placed early, shifted to the outside of rivals and chased four wide to the turn, difted out a path into upper stretch, battled while within aim into the final sixteenth then was outkicked in deep stretch. THE NOTHING MAKER off a step slowly leaving the start, chased three wide to the turn, advanced two wide into the stretch, could not sustain that run into the final sixteenth and flattened out late. CHINO MIRAGE was rank leaving the start, took up in the early stages and was off slowly, trailed to the turn, swung widest into upper stretch and offered a mild late rally. CREE sent to be prominent early, contested the moderate pace two wide and between foes heading to the turn, disputed the pace to the quarter pole then battled into upper stretch, stayed on to the furlong grounds and weakened in the final sixteenth. JUST GOTTA SHINE showed good early speed from outside of rivals, disputed the pace three wide to the turn, lost position nearing the quarter marker and faded

in the stretch. TAPITSWAY tracked the moderate early pace, saved ground to the turn then tired in the stretch drive.

POWERIZED showed good early speed, cleared the field and set a decent pace from the inside heading to the turn, carved out solid fractions to the quarter pole then kicked to a clear lead into the drive, could not hold off BEARINGS in deep stretch and was a clear second best. DIALED IN TO WIN tracked the early pace from the inside, angled four to five wide into upper stretch then closed well into the final sixteenth, could not impact the top pair late and was clear in the end for third. CODE FIVE prominent early, tracked the pace two wide to the turn, chased three to four wide nearing the quarter marker, battled into the stretch then could not muster the needed late response. SMILING GOODBYE tracked the early pace from the inside, shifted to the two path into the turn and pressed the pace to the quarter marker, could not keep pace into upper stretch and weakened in the drive. MT. ZEROR vied for the early lead from inside of runners, ceded to WE GOT SWAG and pressed inside of that runner into the backstretch, re-bid into the second turn then took command at the guarter pole, kicked clear into the stretch and kept to task into the final sixteenth, met the bid of EARTHLY TIGER in deep stretch and just lasted at the wire to dead-heat for the win. EARTHLY TIGER rated off of the early pace while never far back, tracked to the half-mile pole then was roused two to three wide and between foes into the second turn, chased MT. ZEROR into upper stretch and closed well into the final furlong, drew to even terms with MT. ZEROR into deep stretch, could not get by that rival at the wire and dead-heated for the win. UNAUDITED tracked the early pace four to five wide to the first turn, took back and was well placed nearing the half-mile pole, chased five wide to the quarter marker, maintained a wide trip into the stretch, responded to urging in the lane then stubbornly stayed on into the final sixteenth and was outfinished by the top pair in deep stretch, while well clear of the rest for third.
