GLORY N THEHIGHEST pressed the pace in the three path, bid under a ride passing the quarter, took the lead at the top of the lane, edged clear of the inner pacesetter around the sixteenth, and held off a late charging outer foe. CHAINSAW CITY chased in the two path, was ridden along the inside around the far turn, angled out to the four path passing the furlong grounds, and rallied for place late. HAPPY IS showed the way along the inside, came under pressure in the two path passing the quarter, lost the lead at the top of the lane, flattened in the final furlong, but held show. RABBLE bumped with an outer foe at the start, tracked inside, was coaxed along in the three path midway around the far turn, and finished evenly in the five path down the stretch. POCKET KNIFE bumped with an inner foe at the start, rated inside, was driven in the two path around the far turn, but made no impact. CHOKECHERY SHARI stalked in the four path but retreated. GARAVANI got fractious in the gate which delayed the start, checked early into the first turn, trailed up the backstretch, was driven in the three path around the far turn, but never menaced.
