GLOBAL AGENDA was forwardly placed racing three-wide, moved up to take the lead frim HAPPY RANCH leaving the eighth pole and quickly drew clear. MAESTRO ITALIANO saved ground while being reserved off the pace, angled out to be three-wide leaving the eighth pole and finished strongly. HAPPY RANCH saved ground setting the pace to the eighth pole and held in fairly well for third when headed. ARIZONA MOON RISE raced in the back of the field, came four-wide into the stretch and improved his position. TEMPTING MISCHIEF broke in to bump with APOLLINAR GRAYDAR then prompted the early pace racing two-wide and tired. MANX MISSILE raced in the middle of the pack while two-wide and was not a factor. APOLINAR GRAYDAR was bumped at the start by TEMPTING MISCHIEF then allowed to settle, was pulled up nearing the three-eighths pole and was transported off the track via the equine ambulance.
