STANDARD OF PROOF prompted SIR LUCAS racing two-wide, took the lead from that one entering the stretch and quickly drew clear. CANDY'S CHROME was prominently placed racing two-wide and finished well for second in a steady effort. MALA was unhurried early, rallied five-wide into the stretch and rallied late. FIVE TWENTY SUNSET was close-up early racing along the inside and weakened. MOONLIGHT ROAD bobbled at start then was allowed to settle while racing three-wide but lacked a rally. SIR LUCAS saved ground setting the pace to the stretch and tired.
