SONG OF SONGS lacked speed, worked between horses the far turn, swung to the four path at the head of the stretch, launched a determined rally outside TOPIC THUNDER, swept to command approaching the finish and drove clear. TOPIC THUNDER bumped with KNAUGHTY KNIGHT leaving the starting gate, stalked the pace down the backstretch, moved up four deep on the turn, angled in when taking the lead entering the stretch, was clear in mid stretch, continued gamely but was out finished. PLAYFUL sped to the front, set a pressured pace along the inner rail, was overtaken leaving the far turn, checked behind TOPIC THUNDER entering the stretch and finished well. STRATIA stalked the pace near the inner rail, failed to keep up on the far turn, angled out and finished willingly. TIGER LADY lacked speed, circled the far turn three wide and gave way. RUN YOUR MOUTH was outrun. KNAUGHTY KNIGHT bumped with TOPIC THUNDER at the start, prompted the pace, gave way and drifted very wide entering the stretch. There was a stewards' inquiry and an objection by the rider of PLAYFUL against TOPIC THUNDER for alleged interference near the quarter pole but no action was taken.
