LOVEABOVEANDBEYOND , quickly to the front, secured the inside and set a rated pace while handling outer pressure, spurted away while nursed mid way on the final turn, responded when set down near the three sixteenths, remained well clear under a drive past the furlong grounds, switched over to her left lead in deep stretch and prevailed. KITTY HOUSE drafted back off the early pace, trailed while being angled out into the far turn, swung four to five wide for the drive, leveled off near mid stretch when swithching to her correct lead and continued on well to bridge the gap. ZIPPIN SEVENZ broke in the air and was away a few lengths last, regrouped and edged up three deep to a stalking spot, shifted in leaving the far turn, angled out with a run into the stretch, chased on past mid stretch then flattened out late. TWO BAR , between runners into and around the first turn, angled out for the bacskrtetch run, chased three wide past the five sixteenths but failed to muster up a serious stretch response. PLATINUM DIVA , inside a pair of rivals through about the opening five sixteenths, remained inside with pursuit into the stretch but lacked a bid. PEAK EARNINGS (GB) shadowed the winner to the far turn, saw that one get away leaving the three eighths, gave futile chase past the quarter pole and weakened.
