CANCUN NATIVE broke a step slow, quickly recovered and pulled his way forward to stalk behind the leaders, eased off the inside past the five sixteenths and set his sights on the front runner, bid three wide from the outside entering the lane, gained a slim advantage a furlong out, dueled under solid asking and held firm. F B I BOB edged up inside rivals to contest the early pace, moved clear near the half, edged away a bit mid turn, entered the lane two wide bracing for the outer winner, lost command near the furlong grounds, dug down to battle on from there then gave way grudgingly in the final yards. SEB N' SAM , off the pace saving ground, edged up mid turn then was paused off heels near the quarter pole, shifted out, worked between rivals inside the sixteenth pole, shifted out late and finished well. PRINCE OF MEMPHIS disputed the pace outside F B I BOB early on, chased that one three to four wide from the five sixteenths and kept on trying to the wire. QUEBRANCHO dropped back off the early pace, saved ground into the lane, angled out near mid stretch, had to wait a bit with a sixteenth to go then finished up with interest. BOTTLE CAPS chased behind foes nearing the turn, saved ground into the lane, remained inside with an advance past mid stretch then faded late under some hand coaxing. G DAWG , three to four wide early, circled five wide into the stretch but lacked a rally. BLACKSOD BAY , with the leaders four wide into the turn, failed to keep pace five wide in upper stretch and faded. REACH HIGHER , off the pace and under asking mid turn, angled four wide approaching the stretch, chased to the inside of a rival but failed to respond.
