BARBIES FURY stalked in the two path, ranged up around the far turn to bid under a ride passing the quarter, took command while in the four path at the top of the lane, drew clear passing the furlong grounds, and held sway. MS. BUZZINGA rated in the three path, was driven in the two path around the far turn, swung out to the six path at th top of the stretch, and ran on to edge out place. GOLDEN MIDNIGHT raced off the pace in the five path, was coaxed along in the three path around the far turn, got carried out to the seven path at the top of the lane, and kept on for show. FAE ALLANNAH laid in range in the two path, was ridden along the inside around the far turn, but flattened in the final furlong. MAY SURPRISE bumped with an inner foe at the start, was wellback in the two path early and made no impact. CIRCLE OF FIRE set the pace in the three path, rounded the far turn while ridden along from the two path, but gave way from the three path down the stretch. BANDERSNATCH bumped between foes at the start, was wellback in the three path early and did not factor. MAGIC AUTHORITY broke out and bumped an outer foe, tracked inside but retreated around the far turn. BRASCIA'S ART got bumped by an inner foe into an outer foe at the start, laid up close in the three path but yielded around the far turn.
