LOGICAL MYTH was settled while two wide on the backstretch, waited for clear racing room from the quarter pole to late stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and closed like a rocket to be up in the final strides in a game effort. AFJAN was settled in the early going while inside, started a run into the far turn, rallied four wide at the top of the stretch then lugged in mid stretch and bumped with FIREMAN DAN then took the lead but was caught in the final strides. STANDARD OF PROOF vied for the lead while between rivals on the backstretch, was in a long sustained rive in the stretch but hung in late stretch. DRINKING AGAIN vied for the lead while inside, was in a long drive and dug in but weakened in late stretch. FIREMAN DAN vied for the lead while three wide on the backstretch, was in a long drive then was bumped in mid stretch by AFJAN then steadied and shifted out to be five wide and lacked a late bid. PESO was chasing the early pace while inside, saved ground on the far turn and made a bid in upper stretch but came up empty in late stretch. BIG JACK trailed and was outrun. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of FIREMAN DAN against the rider of AFJAN for interference in mid stretch. A steward's inquiry was held concerning the stretch run. After reviewing the film's, the steward's disqualified AFJAN from second and was placed fifth for interference in the stretch.
