HAIL STATE duelled for the lead while inside throughout, was in a long hard drive and gamely dug in to win the head bob in the final stride. GREAT KING (FR) was chasing the early pace while three wide into the turn, rallied on the turn and duelled two wide in the stretch, was in a strong drive but lost the head bob in the final stride. WINTER FALCON was allowed to settled while two wide in the early going, rallied and angled out to be four wide in upper stretch then made a mild gain in late stretch. TOOLITTLETOOLATE duelled for the early lead while two wide into the turn, was used up then faltered in the stretch. TRACK ROBBER was unruly in the gate just at the gates opened then was far back, made a run into the turn then failed to menace in the stretch. SON O' SANPETE was unhurried early and outrun.
