WHITE PEONY broke a beat slow, quickly recovered and was nudged up to contention, disputed the pace between runners while nicely handled poked a head in front heading to the quarter pole, responded when roused and shook clear soon into the lane, remained on her left lead and held firm under a drive. BELIEVE IN HER settled in range and off the inside, angled out leaving the three eighths, circled five wide into the lane, made a grinding run through the final furlong and earned the place while switching to the correct lead in the final yards. GOLDEN MIDNIGHT, with the pace three deep, battled outside rivals into and around the final turn, shifted out four wide for the drive and kept on with effort. SIEMPRE NAMAN rated off heels early then secured the inside, stalked the embattled trio, was under pressure past the five sixteenths, slipped through along the inner rail in upper stretch but came up empty. THETRIbehASSPOKEN took over early, set a pressured pace inside two rivals, ceded command leaving the five sixteenths and weakened in the final furlong.
