GENERAL THAYER bore in leaving the starting gate, advanced three deep on the turn, wrested command in upper stretch, opened up in mid stretch and held sway under pressure. WINTER FALCON lacked speed, angled out on the turn, floated to the five path turning for home and closed nicely. BRAZEN NOW circled foes three wide on the turn, drifted out entering the stretch and had a mild rally outside rivals. UPRIGHT raced in mid pack around the turn, worked between horses and rallied. WHISKY MY GOD (ARG) dueled outside TOO TALL TO CALL and weakened the final furlong. REAL GOOD MAGIC saved ground on the turn and was not a factor. BIG DON'S SMILING saved ground on the turn, swung out in upper stretch and failed to rally. SONIC BREES , steadied when squeezed back leaving the starting gate, swung six wide turning for home and lacked a rally. TOO TALL TO CALL , reluctant to load into the starting gate, was hustled to the front, hugged the rail disputing the pace and gave way in upper stretch.
