POKER ALICE was unhurried in the three path, roused while angling out passing the quarter, fanned out to the eight path entering the stretch, and rallied past inner rivals to draw ahead in the closing stages. CHAMAVILLE was wellback in the two path, improved along the rail around the far turn, had to steady passing the quarter, but ran on between foes from the four path down the stretch for place. VRONSKY FEINT was up close in the three path, ridden around the far turn, bid while floating out to the five path at the top of the lane, held command passing the furlong grounds, but got out-finished by rivals on both sides late to show. VULIN chased in the two path, was ridden between foes passing the quarter, floated out to the six path down the lane, and kept on.

ENGLISH DANGER hopped at the start, trailed in the four path early, improved under a drive around the far turn, swung out to the seven path turning into the lane, and finished evenly. YOGYA rated in the three path, was coaxed along into the far turn, but finished on one pace in the five path down the stretch. DERRYGOOLIN tracked inside, was cued from the rail passing the quarter, but flattened in the final furlong. HAPPY IS set the pace in the two path, was cued passing the quarter, then fought on in upper stretch before retreating in the final furlong. FOREST ACCLAMATION stalked in the four path turning into the backstretch but was empty at the top of the lane. RIBBONS AND LACE raced in range between foes from the three path, lost ground around the far turn, had to check passing the quarter, then weakened.
