EMBRACEABLE YOU was unhurried early then rallied five wide on the turn, was in a long sustained drive and was best in the end. INXPRESS chased the early pace while three wide on the backstretch, rallied four wide in upper stretch and was in a strong drive but was second best in the end. CHAINSAW CITY was unhurried early then rallied on the turn, was four wide in the stretch and closed willingly in the end. READY TO DARE dueled for the lead while inside into the turn, was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. PETITE ANGE dueled for the lead while two wide into the turn, was in a long drive but faltered in the stretch. LOOKOUT PASS was unhurried early and failed to menace. SNEAKY SITUATION chased the early pace while inside into the turn, was used up-then gave way.
