BABY WAYLON dueled for the early lead from the inside, was well handled then drew away in mid stretch and was clearly the best in the end. RENEW rallied four wide on the turn and stayed outside in the stretch drive, was gaining ground and was up for the place in the end. HATAGASAL was pressing the early pace while between rivals, was shuffled back on the turn then came again from the inside in the stretch in late stretch to be gaining ground. HUGH GLASS dueled for the lead while two wide on the turn, was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. G DAWG chased the early pace while two wide into the turn, was used up then weakened in late stretch. STREET GUN rallied three wide on the turn making a bid then flattened out in the stretch drive. BIG JIMMY chased the early pace while inside into the turn then faltered. CONVEY TO ME was settled then swung out to be five wide on the turn and was no threat. BOTTLE CAPS chased the early pace while three wide, was used up then gave way.
