TIGER LADY was settled inside and saving ground into the turn, waited behind the leaders then angled out quickly two wide before the furlong pole off heels then was in a strong drive and powered to the front in late stretch to be best in the end. TRAIN STATION was settled then rallied on the turn, was two wide then angled out to be four wide before the furlong pole for clear running room then was gaining ground and finished well. SMART ALTERNATIVE was allowed to settled then raced three wide on the turn, moved out to be five wide in mid stretch was gaining ground but was no menace in the end. LOTSA KITTY chased the early pace while three wide into the turn, made a bid two wide in the stretch but was out finished in late stretch. FOURLYNNES was unhurried early then was inside on the turn and no threat. DEEP DESIRES set a pressured pace from the inside, was used up then gave way. An objection was lodged by the trainer of SMART ALTERNATIVE against the rider of TRAIN STATION for interference in mid stretch. After reviewing the film's, no action was taken.
