WINTER FALCON set the pace near the inner rail, saved ground on the turn, drifted wide entering the stretch, was challenged on his outside in upper stretch, dueled and tenaciously prevailed. READY TO STORM , a forward factor outside the winner throughout, was fanned very wide turning for home, bid for the lead then dueled in a game performance. BLACKJACK AND BEER chased inside horses, saved ground around the turn and finished gamely. HOUSE OF LORDS , checked and rank in close quarters about a sixteenth of a mile after the break, raced near the inner rail on the turn and in upper stretch, angled out in mid stretch and flattened out. GIANOLA , three wide leaving the turn, lacked a rally. BIG DON'S SMILING , three deep entering the turn, drifted five wide leaving the bend and came up empty in the stretch.
