BOUNDLESS OPTIMIST , steadied in tight quarters along the rail entering the first turn, remained along the rail, moved to the three path in upper stretch, closed inside ENGLISH ICON, drifted out and bumped with that one near the finish. ENGLISH ICON stalked the pace, advanced three wide on the far turn, floated to the four path in upper stretch, gained the lead in mid stretch, gave way grudgingly and drifted in bumping with the winner near the wire. FLEET BROTATO lacked speed, circled the far turn four wide, floated to the six path in upper stretch and rallied. TEDDY PANTAGES broke slowly, trailed to the stretch, swung outside near the sixteenth pole and rallied. TOWHEE , rank behind horses early, checked in traffic entering the first turn, swung outside, rushed up leaving the backstretch, challenged for the lead on the far turn and tired. NOAH'S GOLD made the pace along the inner rail, was hooked entering the far turn and gave way in mid stretch. OSWALD , angled to the five path in upper stretch, weakened. An objection by the rider of ENGLISH ICON against the winner for alleged interference near the finish was not allowed. There was a stewards' inquiry concerning the stretch drive but no action was taken. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
