CHAMAVILLE rated in the three path, inched closer around the far turn, was cued passing the quarter, swung from the five path into the lane, bid passing the furlong grounds, and inched ahead. ENGLISH DANGER trailed inside the backstretch, steadied in the two path entering the far turn, was coaxed along around the far turn, and ran on in the three path down the stretch to edge out place. VULIN prompted the pace around the first turn, took back to track entering the backstretch, advanced to take the lead from the two path entering the far turn, was coaxed along around the far turn, kept on down the lane, but got out-finished by an outer pair to show. FOREST ACCLAMATION set the pace in the two path, lost the lead along the inside entering the far turn, fought on from the rail down the stretch, but got out-lasted. ALICESHOUSEOFHEART stalked in the three path, bid under coaxing from the two path approaching the quarter, but flattened in the four path down the stretch. A STEWARDS INQUIRY AS WELL AS AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF ENGLISH DANGER AGAINST THE RIDER OF CHAMAVILLE FOR INTERFERENCE ENTERING THE FAR TURN RESULTED IN NO CHANGE. This race originally had a timing malfunction or discrepancy, and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.
