EYE ON RY tracked the pace while saving ground, took closer order leaving the far turn, slipped through along the inside to challenge in upper stretch, wrested command under right handed asking near the furlong grounds then dug in tenaciously to narrowly fend off an outer bid from FOUND MY BALL. FOUND MY BALL settled in the clear, gathered momentum off the rail leaving the far turn, shifted out four wide for the drive, closed in outside a trio of rivals, drifted in briefly near the sixteenth pole, corrected to bid outside the winner but just could not get past. BENANDONNER, between foes early, stalked outside the winner leaving the far turn, loomed three wide into the stretch, chased on past the eighth pole but lacked the needed finish. WOOD CEILING cleared off in the opening furlong, set the pace under some rating, was under coaxing off the rail into the stretch, failed to deny the winner's inside bid then faded late. LOGICAL MYTH drafted back after an alert start, raced well back into the turn, came three wide for the drive and failed to menace. MY CAIRO KID, well detached from rivals through the backstretch run, angled out in the drive and had a belated but non threatening response. I AM FREAKY FAST, three wide early, angled in and was urged along leaving the far turn, failed to kick on nearing the lane and weakened.
