BIG JIMMY was settled while three wide into the turn, rallied and was in a long sustained drive and was best in the end. PAKAS SECRET dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long hard drive but weakened in late stretch and held the place safe. MAJOR PAYNE was saving ground into the turn then rallied and moved out to be four wide for the stretch drive, was gaining ground and finished well. LEVI GONE WILD was inside and saving ground on the turn, was blocked in upper stretch then angled out to be three wide in mid stretch but was no menace in late stretch. CHICK COMMAND was unhurried early then raced five wide on the turn but was no threat. EMPIRE WARRIOR was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the turn but was no threat in the stretch. STREET GUN dueled for the early lead while inside, was hard used then gave way in the stretch.
