BABY WAYLON bore in and bumped with TWELFTH NIGHT leaving the starting gate, circled the first turn three wide in hand, stalked the duel, closed determinedly outside rivals and was up approaching the finish. NOW THEN broke well and made the early lead, remained along the rail, dueled with TWELFTH NIGHT leaving the backstretch and around the far turn, sprinted clear in upper stretch and gave way grudgingly. TWELFTH NIGHT bumped with the winner leaving the starting gate, was eager to go soon after, engaged NOW THEN leaving the backstretch, dueled with that one and weakened the final furlong. RESULTANT, between horses down the back and on the far turn, swung very wide in upper stretch, raced outside horses and passed tired ones. SPUN NOT STIRRED remained along the inner rail for most of the raced and was no factor. VERDI broke slowly, stayed along the inner rail on the turns, moved out in upper stretch and weakened. EVANDERKEEN, wide, was outrun.
