BEL RAGAZZO settled far back and well off the inside, was given the cue nearing the far turn, made a bold six wide run from the three eighths to the quarter pole, kept on with a steady progression from there and gained outside the top pair. KIRBY DERBY, five wide nearing the quarter pole, offered a mild late kick. ITS BIG, off the early pace, moved up to the inside of rivals leaving the far turn, eased out nearing the lane, shifted back in but lacked the needed finish.
