HAKUHIA was allowed to settle, came under coaxing three wide on the turn and came five wide into the lane and closed full of run to draw clear in the final sixteenth to prove best under a drive. BEYOND THE LAW set a pressured pace on the inside and shook clear leaving the turn but could not go with the winner in the final sixteenth while being second best. SCREAMING VIRGINIA was allowed to settle early two wide and had a late rally to gain the show award late. BEVERLY T prompted the pace three wide and then pressed the pace in between rivals on the turn but faded in the lane losing the show award late. BURNIN AT MIDNIGHT pressed the early pace in between rivals and fell back on the turn. LUNA LINDA prompted the early pace and made a four wide bid on the turn to vie for command to the quarter pole but weakened in the final sixteenth. LUCKY NEA was hustled along early and then steadied and fell back and weakened on the inside.
