ARIO stalked outside a rival early on, quickly gained approaching the stretch and reeled in the leader from his outside, kicked clear under a drive leaving mid stretch, wandered inward while widened near the sixteenth pole then dug in late to maintain a clear advantage. DELIAN LEAGUE settled off the pace, gathered momentum off the rail past the five sixteenths, angled out and circled five wide into the stretch, advanced outside foes in mid stretch and finished well to gain. WINE EMPIRE saved ground off the early pace, was under a hustling ride leaving the far turn, angled three wide into the stretch and churned on. PURE CANE SUGAR, in a bit close nearing the first turn, regrouped and saved ground, gained along the rail leaving the five sixteenths, angled out, moved up between runners in deep stretch then flattened out very late. RUN BRYCE RUN, off the pace, saved ground advancing past the five sixteenths, angled out, worked through traffic in mid stretch, shifted in and kept on with interest. KITTEN IN CHARGE, four then three wide, was briefly stalled near the three eighths, worked outward in the drive but needed more. STAR MISSION, three wide between rivals early, chased outside a runner through the backstretch and faded. BOURBON DANCER, four wide off the pace, failed to generate a rally. CODE BREAKER stalked the pace while saving ground and to the inside of the winner, failed to kick on in upper stretch and weakened. SANDERSON, quickly clear, was a bit keen setting the pace towards the inner rail, widened to the half, saw his lead diminish into the stretch, gave little resistance once joined then faltered nearing the sixteenth pole. DINERO DE LA CASA hesitated at the break and was away last, was a bit rank soon after, lagged back, saved ground into the stretch and failed to get involved. There was a stewards' inquiry into the start of DINERO DE LA CASA. No action was deemed necessary.
