Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

CHASENTHEONE came in at the start, moved clear and set the pace shifting in nearer the inside, drifted out a bit leaving the far turn and in the stretch, held sway under steady handling. SHUT UP MICHAEL (IRE) was a bit fractious in the gate, stalked the winner near the inside, ran evenly and fought on enough to save the place. SONIC SPEED was just a little tight and slow at the break, tucked in at the back outside a foe, began to advance on the far turn about three to four wide, kept on outside a foe but couldn't get up for place. SUMMER LOVER settled at the back inside, could see them all past the quarter pole, swung six wide into upper stretch and passed foes outside. RODEO CHAMP stalked mostly two to three wide and was one-paced. LAW ABIDING in just a bit tight at the start and slow into stride, was caught four wide into the first turn racing off the pace, made an early advance outside foes up the backstretch, was urged along past the three-eighths, drew close to even under all out urging at the top of the stretch but thereupon flattened out. CLIFF DIVER was off the pace three to four wide and never near enough to threaten. CROSS THE CAUSEWAY saved ground to no avail.
