GO CATS settled off the pace removed from the fence, advanced late up the backstretch splitting foes nearing the three-eighths, tipped out a bit to bid past the quarter pole, drew clear in upper stretch, was eased up late when safely in front. MT. ZEROR settled mid-division inside into the first turn, dropped back to last up the backstretch, switched out at the half, began to advance on the far turn swinging seven wide into upper stretch, was no match but clearly second best. GODDARD was caught four then three wide into the first turn, tracked nearer the inside mid-pack up the backstretch, altered out past the quarter pole, ran on to get show honors. LEMON MERINGUE was forwardly-placed outside four to five wide through the first turn, stalked up the backstretch, was within range under urging still four to five deep on the far turn, lacked the needed late kick. DON'T HAVE ANOTHER settled off the inside at the rear, passed foes. CREATIVE OM was strongly urged forward at the start to move clear and shift in, set the pace, gave way. EL DIAMANTE NEGRO switched outside the leader entering the first turn, stalked from outside, faltered and faded.
