Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

CHIEF RENEGADE disputed the pace outside CHARLIE THYME, went clear in mid stretch then drew off under steady handling. BOOMING BERNARDO, a forward factor early, raced in the path on the turn, came into the stretch between horses and gained the place. CHARLIE THYME showed speed, saved ground on the turn dueling with the winner and weakened the final furlong. FANCY DANCER, four wide on the turn, raced between horses in the stretch and passed tired ones. SEB N' SAM, four deep on the turn, was well positioned in upper stretch and weakened. WARREN'S C J, reluctant to load into the starting gate, was far back around the turn, found room along the inner rail through the stretch and showed a late move. COME HOME, bumped by FANTASMA soon after the break, raced in the three path leaving the turn, swung very wide and failed to be a factor. FANTASMA, steadied when bearing in and bumping COME HOME leaving the starting gate, was outrun. POCO YO, a forward factor along the inner rail down the backstretch, steadied in narrow quarters entering the turn, chased and weakened. WHY NOT MAYZEE, no factor, dropped back.
