YES HE CAN chased in the two path, was driven in the three path around the turn, took aim while angling out to the six path at the top of the lane, and kicked on to draw ahead of an inner foe in the closing stages. IMMELMANN pressed in the three path, bid from the two path midway around the turn, swung from the five path into the stretch, ran on to lead passing the sixteenth pole, but was overtaken by an outer foe late. STAR ENTRY raced towards the back of the pack in the two path, was ridden around the turn, angled out to the seven path passing the eighth pole, and rallied late for show. SHACKLEFORD STRONG raced off the pace in the four path, was driven around the turn, got carried out to the eight path down the stretch, but kept on. GOOD LOVIN set the pace in the two path, waited around the turn, was roused while floating out to the four path at the top of the lane, dug in until the sixteenth pole, then yielded. RUNTODAY prompted the early pace along the inside but faded in the stretch. SON O' SANPETE trailed throughout from the three to four paths.
