## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

SMOOCHING bumped with an inner foe at the start, tracked in the two path, was driven around the turn, angled out to the five path at the top of the lane, and rallied ahead of inner rivals in the closing stages. BIRDIE CURDY rated in the three path, was coaxed passing the three-eighths pole, swung out to the six path at the top of the stretch, and rallied for place late. SHANGHAI BARBIE pressed in the two path, bid under a ride midway around the turn, dug in from the three path down the lane, led passing the eighth pole, but was caught by an outer pair in closing stages. BOSTON PRINCESS bumped with an outer foe at the start, stalked the leading duo, bid under a ride in the three path passing the quarter, led from the four path at the top of the lane, but lost the lead nearing the eighth pole, and finished evenly. DANSMETOTHENDOFLOV was wellback in the three path, driven in the four path around the turn, fanned out to the eight path at the top of the lane, and rallied late. ACCLAIMED PREACHER raced off the pace inside, was ridden around the turn, stayed on down the stretch, but flattened in the final sixteenth. PRINCESS PAYTON trailed in the two path, was coaxed along around the turn, and improved from the three path down the lane. CLASSIC AMERICAN set the pace inside, was cued passing the quarter, but gave way in the stretch. CAN'T WANT THAT raced in range in the three path early but retreated.
