CANDY'S WILDCAT raced close up to the early pace while inside of rivals, got caught in tight approaching the turn and steadied off of heels at the three-eighths marker, chased the leading trio heading to the quarter marker then angled four wide to upper stretch, was full of run to the final sixteenth and got up in time for a determined win. STRETCH RUN was forwardly placed leaving the gate, went up and disputed the pace between foes heading into the turn, pressed to the quarter marker then gamely battled into upper stretch, took command into the final sixteenth, was tagged by the oncoming winner in deep stretch and held for second at the wire. JAIME'S COMMITMENT showed good speed away from the start, disputed the pace four then three wide heading to the turn, took a narrow lead along the bend and set contested fractions to the quarter pole, battled a pair of rivals into the stretch, fought stubbornly to the final sixteenth, grudgingly gave way in deep stretch and held for third. HAIL STATE settled off of the contested early pace, was coaxed outside of rivals into the turn then swung five wide to upper stretch, found his best stride late but came up just short. TEDDY'S TRIUMPH showed good speed away from the start, vied for the early lead then pressed from the inside heading into the turn, disputed the decent pace from inside of a pair rivals nearing the quarter marker then battled from the inside into the stretch, could not find more into the final sixteenth and weakened late. RIDIN SOLO settled off of the contested early pace while never far back, saved ground into the turn, swung widest to upper stretch then did not rally in the late stages.
