## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

THE BLACK STRAT was nustled for the early lead, took command and set the pace to the first turn, carved out a solid pace to the half-mile pole, showed the way to the second turn then held sway into upper stretch, raced on a clear lead into the final furlong, kept to task late and held safely in a drive at the wire. I'M NOBLE allowed to settle in the early running, roused two to three wide into the far turn, rallied between rivals into the stretch, angled four wide and closed willingly into the final sixteenth, could not reel in the winner in deep stretch but got up in time to earn the place. DEL RAYO forwardly placed in the early running, stalked the pace while saving ground to the backstretch, was well placed to the far turn then ran in pursuit of THE BLACK STRAT into upper stretch, was outkicked in the final sixteenth and just missed for second at the wire, while just holding for third. ZOFFARELLI (IRE) rated off of the solid early pace, tracked from the second flight into the backstretch, was roused three wide to the far turn, chased THE BLACK STRAT into upper stretch, fought on into the final sixteenth and was outfinished for the minor awards. SUMMER LOVER was unhurried in the early going, trailed to the backstretch then was roused into the far turn, swung five then six wide to upper stretch, showed good late interest but could not reel in the leaders in deep stretch. FIREMAN DAN allowed to settle in the early stages, was roused three then four wide into the far turn, gave chase into the stretch but could not muster the needed final response. DEAR SANTA rated off of the early pace, tracked from the inside heading into the first turn, was well placed while saving ground up the backstretch, waited in traffic along the rail nearing the quarter marker, found room into upper stretch then weakened in the final stages. FROSTEDBIRD close up to the early pace, stalked the solid fractions while two wide to the backstretch, dropped back into the second turn then came up empty in the drive. This race had a timing discr
