## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

XTREME MAYHEM drafted back off the pace and off the inside, edged up behind a host of rivals past the five sixteenths, swung out to the seven path entering the lane, closed steadly under left handed asking, forged to a slim lead outside SAINT PIO with about seventy yards remaining, switched back to his correct lead in the final yards and prevailed. SAINT PIO, five wide outside runners leaving the far turn, circled six wide with progress into the stretch, ranged up to engage the leader past mid stretch, battled on near even terms inside the winner through the final sixteenth, kept on gamely and just missed. COASTAL FOG, away alertly and led for a couple strides, was overtaken then chased four to five wide between rivals, churned on through the final furlong and just got the show over an inner foe. BIG DON'S SMILING, three to four wide between horses, angled in with a furlong to go and kept on with effort. MISTER K, away well, was hung out six wide outside runners heading to the turn, angled out extremely wide for the drive and had belated action. CLOUD BLITZ was loaded without the rider, broke a step slow, recovered and rushed up inside to chase, raced two wide then between foes near mid stretch and came up empty. TOO TALL TO CALL, balked loading, was sent up between rivals to take command after about a furlong, went clear into the turn, opened up a lengthy advantage while under some asking mid turn, began to shorten stride near mid stretch, was overwhelmed by outer foes soon after and faltered through the final sixteenth. ROPER, two wide and to the inside pursuing early, dropped back some leaving the far turn, came back on a bit while saving ground into the stretch then tired through the final furlong.
