RECYCLEYOURHEART broke well but backed out of a developing speed duel, tracked inside to the turn, moved up to challenge three-wide for the lead near the quarter pole, gained command by the eighth pole, and went clear under steady handling. MAX'S MAXINE broke on top, vied between horses early, then settled behind the dueling leader throughout the turn, lost some ground, but was kept to task and produced a grinding finish to move up and grab the second prize. BURNIN AT MIDNIGHT came out a bit after the start and took a bump from VALLEY ECHO, advanced from last through the turn while saving ground, finished with some interest to gain the minor award. CHARMZ showed good early speed, vied inside in the initial stages, then dueled with RABBLE through the turn, got the best of that rival by upper stretch, then weakened in the final furlong. VALLEY ECHO broke well but did not engage in the early pace mix, steadily dropped to last before the turn, made a mild three-wide bid to the stretch but flattened out and was unable to threaten. RABBLE broke sharply, pushed the early pace four-wide early, then dueled with CHARMZ through the turn, gave way under pressure leaving the quarter pole, then had little left to offer in the stretch. ZACANGO PRIDE was up with the early leaders down the backstretch, then weakened early on the turn and was no a factor in the late stages.
