SUPREME LEADER settled behind the main pack as the rest of the field disputed the early pace, got an inside run through the turn,tipped out a path in upper stretch, chased EXTREMELY WICKED down the stretch, got a head in front in the final yards, and held off a late bid from WITHOUT EQUAL to prevail. WITHOUT EQUAL was six-wide in the early pace battle, finished up well, was getting to the eventual winner late, but ran out of time. EXTREMELY WICKED broke best and was sent hard to get the early lead, soon had a horde of challengers on all sides to the turn, pulled away from the pack along with GOOD FOCUS to duel tthrough the turn, got the better of that one by the quarter pole, came into the stretch with a slightt lead, dug in gamely under threat, then gave way grudgingly in the final yards. SERENADER moved up after a slow start, was always loomed a threat but was not quite doing enough in the final furlong. EL SIETE LEGUAS rushed up to join the leaders after a slow start, was close up until late on the turn, then was outfinished in the stretch. MIDNIGHT KID vied five-wide to the quarter pole, then weakened. GOOD FOCUS was in the thick of the early pace battle, then broke away with EXTREMELY WICKED through the turn, then weakened before the stretch and was uninvolved in the late stages.
