KHAIKY'S COMMAND dueled on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and drew off in the lane. GENERAL THAYER stalked the leader on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the bend from the three path and improved position in the stretch. TAINO HOUSE trailed the field through the opening quarter, came around the turn in the two path and made up some mild ground in the lane. COLONEL PUNCH dueled on the outside up the backstretch, continued to battle around the turn in the two path and weakened in the stretch. RIGHT TO SUE raced off the pace on the inside early, came around the turn in the two path and made no bid. DOMINATE tracked the leader on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the bend and faded in the lane.
