YES HE CAN chased the pace, circled the turn three wide, gained command in upper stretch and held sway under brisk urging. WINNING BIG, taken to the five path turning for home, rallied between horses. SCRATCHY APACHE lacked speed, worked between horses in upper stretch, swung outside in mid stretch and closed nicely. MAJOR TOM, caught in tight quarters at the start, worked between horses in the stretch and rallied. STAR ENTRY raced in the two path on the turn, worked between horses and passed tired ones. IMMELMANN showed speed outside SHAUN'S JAZZ, stayed in the two path around the turn, remained prominent to mid stretch then gave way. ALWAYS ON CAY saved ground on the turn and weakened in the drive. MACCHIATO D'ORO four wide on the turn, floated six deep for the drive and weakened. XTREME MAYHEM raced along the inner rail on the turn, offered a mild move to mid stretch and gave way. EL DIAMANTE NEGRO remained along the rail most of the trip while outrun. SHAUN'S JAZZ bore in at the start, was sent to the front soon after that, remained prominent to mid stretch and gave way. STAYSOBER was outrun.
