GIVEMEMYTHEMUSIC had the early lead in hand at the beginning, let the pressing inside rival go on with it relinquishing the front end by the half, moved well hounding the pacesetter throughout the turn, under a confident ride cruised up outside at the top of the lane, seized control with just a shake of the riders hands at the furlong pole and with only mild urging drew off convincingly at the wire. HEAVEN'S CHAMPION prompted the issue four deep, was reined in to track the engaged duo outside midway down the backside, had the outside sitting poised watching the lead duo on the turn, moved in closer when roused at the quarter pole, loomed four wide at the top of the lane but was no match for the winner and settled for a clear second best at the finish line. COMMANDER AT SEA was part of the fray up top leaving the gate, edged up to have a slim lead inside at the half mile marker, continued narrowly up front through the turn taking the short way around, was collared outside by the winner in upper stretch, offered no resistance by the furlong marker and faded in the late stages to hold for the show award. ALPHA KADIN broke slowly then was roused getting better forward position inside at the half tracking the lead duo, edged up on the turn on the front pair to be in the mix two wide straightening out for home but could only finish up evenly in the last furlong to settle for a minor placing. CATHOLIC JACKIE was allowed to settle at the rear with the pack tightly bunched at the half, lagged behind unable to keep up to foes on the bend, skimmed the fence gathering speed at the top of the lane and did show some interest late passing a couple outside rivals in mid-stretch. LONHRO'S GAMBLE travelled four deep stalking outside of horses down the back straight, made little impact going three wide around the turn under a ride, shifted out widest in the five-path turning for home but fail to menace in the stretch running. KNOWING settled just off the rail close to the back end, took the short way around the oval making little headway, angled out to the four path for the stretch run but could not factor in the late drive.

GRAND WARRIOR (JPN) settled between foes in midfield, patiently waited behind the lead trio just off the fence on the turn at the quarter pole, stayed in the two path in with a chance turning for home, darted to the rail coming to the leaders at the sixteenth pole and found another gear late, surging in the final few strides to get up for the late running victory. SPEEDY CONNECTION was in the three path keeping a close eye on the lone speed down the back straight, moved in to bid between horses at the five sixteenths pole, loomed menacingly three wide in upper stretch, got his head in front with seventy yards still to run but was nabbed inside by the charging winner coming to the line. INTERIM ANALYSIS settled on the outside in mid-pack with a half mile remaining, ranged up three to four wide around the oval at the quarter pole to be in the thick of things taking the corner, continued to inch up down the stretch but did not have enough late to threaten for the win while capturing the show award in the end. NOISY CRICKET broke in a bit of a tangle, recouped

smartly to track the lone leader between runners down the backside, assumed control with the frontrunner backing up at the midpoint of the turn, still was holding onto a slim lead on the fence at the top of the lane, dueled stubbornly until surrendering in the final seventy yards and settled on the fringes at the wire. JOSHUA STRIKE hopped at the start trailing down the backside, could not make up any ground on runners throughout the turn, shifted out widest in the five-path turning for home and showed some late energy outside passing some tired runners down the stretch. MAYNARD'S SONG had a slow start then was hustled on the fence leaving the chute to sit inside of runners in mid-division by the half, retreated on the rail through the turn, angled out four wide gathering some momentum in upper stretch but could only run on one paced to the finish line. RAINBOWS HERO had a stalking role ahead of just one runner in the early stages, travelled three wide outside foes on the bend having little to offer, shifted to the four-path straightening out for home but lacked a rally down the stretch. BETTERMUSTCOME had the rail near the rear at the half, came under a ride just off the fence making no progression in the turn running and could not get involved driving down the lane to the finish line. ROYAL FONZ was eager loose on the lead down the backstretch, offered no resistance when collared on the outside at the five sixteenths pole, stopped just off the fence at the top of the lane and was not persevered through the lane cantering across the finish line.

STRATUS was nestled on the rail rating kindly in close range watching the front runner for the first half of this two-turn race, started to get into gear moving out at the five sixteenths pole when nudged for more. lengthened stride sharply at the quarter pole coming with a good rally, pounced three wide between foes in upper stretch and was kept busy to the wire, edging away for the win in the late going. SILVER RALEIGH was content sitting on the outside shadowing the pacesetter, moved in quickly to seize command on the outside midway on the far turn, was collared outside by the winner at the head of the lane, dug in for a while in upper stretch but gave way grudgingly in the final furlong to be a solid second best. STARVIN was unhurried trailing in the beginning, loped along under a good hold improving slightly inside down the backstretch, picked up the bit shifting out four wide at the quarter pole to pose a threat widest in the five path at the top of the stretch but stalled in the final furlong to be a clear third. CARNEW had a good set-up waiting on the rail drafting just behind the pacesetter down the backside as well as throughout the turn, scraped paint threading the needle when called upon for more in upper stretch and boldly darted through a tight seam inside at the sixteenth pole to win going away at the finish line. SAMMYSAURUS REX controlled the pace in the early going up top, continued on the front end with mild pressure applied by the outside rival around the oval, determinedly was clinging onto the lead with runners bearing down from the left and right in upper stretch, did not switch leads through the lane but still fought on valiantly to be a solid best behind the winner who have a dream trip. KOKOMO prompted the issue on the outside down the backstretch, chased in earnest outside around the bend, shifted to the three-path battling outside at the head of the lane, never wavered to the finish line, just missed getting up late for the place share while capturing the show money instead at the wire. HIGHLAND BLUE settled under a snug hold in the middle of the pack at the half, was coaxed along saving ground inside two others sharing the rear through the turn, angled out in the four path with a chance for a piece of the prize in touch of the leaders straightening out for the drive but could only finish up gradually to garner a minor share in the end. MY COVENANT stalked close to the back with runners on either side, remained part of the back trio still between horses around the bend, swung out widest in the five path in upper stretch but could not get involved in the late running. GUERRA was patiently allowed to settle into stride sharing the back inside the troubled starter in the early stages, began to pick up the bit shifting outside coming up to the two-furlong pole, angled out three wide in upper stretch, moved out further getting a clear run at the leader in the five path by the furlong marker and was full of run late, rushing home in the last sixteenth of a mile to get the nod right on the line outside for the late charging win. MISTER BLUE was headstrong fighting the rider loose up top going in the five path along the backside, settled down moving well within himself unchallenged in command around the turn, had the fence up top by a good margin with a furlong to go, began to get leg weary late not switching leads with rivals outside bearing down, veered out sharply under steady left handed encouragement trying to hold for the win in deep stretch bumping the outside foe right at the finish while getting nabbed outside for the win. WAR LEGEND travelled in mid-division on the outside, started to uncork a run four wide at the quarter pole, angled to the five path reaching for more ground smartly at the top of the lane, closed in resolutely with aim on the frontrunner at the sixteenth pole and was bumped, being checked between horses in a blanket finish right at the wire for the top three spots. ATERYA had inside position in mid-pack, rallied inside foes at the quarter pole, hugged the rail in the conversation turning for home but evened out in the stretch run in the final furlong for a minor placing well back of the lead trio. EQUITY had a tracking role on the outside of another, was under a vigorous ride being passed by horses on either side leaving the quarter pole, shifted to the four path in tight surroundings at the top of the stretch, did not switch leads in the drive and wilted in the final furlong. STORMY CLOUD travelled on the rail watching the loose leader down the backside, started to close in just off the fence around the turn by the quarter pole, shifted out just a touch in the three path in the mix between runners in upper stretch but folded by the sixteenth pole. TRANQUILLO stumbled on the break, settled near the

rear at the half, came under a ride three wide on the oval making little gain outside of runners, moved to the five path for the drive to the finish line but made little impression driving down the lane. BEYOND ADVERSITY buckled on the break bouncing the rider up off the saddle trailing along the backside, could not get things going throughout the turn still at the back, hugged the rail for the drive but could not play a factor in the late running due to the compromised beginning. HIGHWAYTOTHEMOON dictated the pace in hand up top down the backstretch, cruised comfortably around the turn with the rider sitting still up front with a rival prompting the issue outside on the turn, edged away on the rail in upper stretch repelling the early speed foe then was kept to the task in the last furlong to find another gear in deep stretch to hold off the late closing runner outside, prevailing at the finish line for the gate to wire score. MILITARY TIME had a good trip tracking the engaged duo, sat isolated waiting for the cue to move still watching the lead pair duel it out around the bend, loomed four wide angling out at the top of the stretch, came with a good rally but was denied by the winner who had something in reserve for the late going. BRACHETTO sat all alone in midfield down the backside, remained in the middle of the pack but when scrubbed on at the quarter pole began to inch up on the turn, skimmed the fence in with a chance at the top of the lane, moved out for clear run three wide at the furlong pole and closed belatedly to be a solid but non threatening third. THUNDERMAKER was content to sit just off and outside tracking the pacesetter along the backstretch, moved in on the outside flank of the frontrunner pressing the issue around the bend, angled to the three path in the hunt battling between rivals in upper stretch for the lead, could not find more in the late going and faded inside of runners in the final furlong to be a fringe player. AMORE MIO had a stalking role ahead of only the poor starter, shared the back inside another with a half mile still to run, narrowed the margin travelling just off the fence through the oval but could not make any impact on the rail in the final furlong. ITSASTORMYMONDAY was coaxed forward and made the lead inside entering the first turn, set the pace in the clear, kicked away in mid-stretch and held under moderate urging. KEKOA had some minor bumps in the early going when in tight, raced off the rail moving up inside a foe heading to the far turn, came out seven wide for the drive, rallied outside a rival for place. LAC MACAZA came in early moving forward, stalked mostly three to four wide, kept on but was outkicked for place. LEGAL CATCH was forced in exchanging a bump and placed in tight quarters early, raced off the rail, advanced up the backstretch into the far turn two to three wide, swung nine deep coming into upper stretch, needed more late but preserved the minor award. EL KABONG had a minor bump early, shifted in nearer the inside into the first turn settling off the pace, swung ten wide into upper stretch, ran on mildly outside runners late. CRUMLIN LAD moved forward outside, stalked the eventual winner, asked to pick it up at the quarter pole, faded in the lane. MASON'S GAMBLE tracked inside the third flight saving ground, came out four wide turning for home, failed to produce a bid. DADDY HAS DIAMONDS lacked early speed racing outside toward the rear three to four deep, swung nine wide into upper stretch moving out eleven wide soon after, made no bids. CASH THE MONEY tracked from inside saving ground just in behind the eventual winner, came up empty. SOUTHERN STYLE raced at the back off the inside two to four wide, came out a bit in the stretch, was never near enough to threaten. MASTERFUL MOMENT bobbed at the start, moved forward some but checked inside entering the first turn dropping back, saved ground inside at the rear and was not a factor.

ZIO CAVALLLO had the lead on the rail along the backside, edged away increasing the advantage at the three-furlong pole, was nursed along through the turn holding off runners, burst away again rationing out the speed in upper stretch and coasted home for the front running tally. TIHO SRCE travelled on the

outside in mid-division, edged closer three wide midway along the bend, shifted to the three path for the drive and offered a very solid late charge while drifting in under right-handed encouragement at the furlong pole to get up late on the rail to best the rest for the runners up share. HUMORMEASTORY had a slow beginning seeing the field along the backside, commenced a run at the quarter pole inside, swung out to the nine path with a full head of steam gobbling up ground in the lane and stormed home with an impressive late charge to be a clear third with the sustained rally outside. FORESTERS LASTLOVE broke inwards on the start, had a stalking trip ahead of a couple of rivals along the backside, closed the gap on the turn by the quarter pole, moved to the eight path for the stretch run and finished up with intent to get up for the minors just at the wire. MASTER STEAL had a tracking position watching the lead group of four down the backside on the outside, circled runners progressing smartly five wide around the turn, shifted to the three path in the hunt at the top of the lane, could not keep going and stalled by the sixteenth pole losing a couple of positions late. UP N THE ANTE was near the rear ahead of only the troubled starter along the back straight, had little to offer on the bend to be in last shifting out to widest in the ten path straightening out for home but showed some resolve to pass many runners in the final furlong finding his best stride very late. EUBANK vied between horses in the two path early on, chased the leader in vain through the oval, began to get leg weary with the winner getting away even further in upper stretch and wilted on the rail in the last sixteenth of a mile. TANIST had the rail watching the lead foursome, came under a busy ride keeping pace with the leader on the turn taking the short way around, hugged the rail fighting for a small share with the winner long gone in upper stretch, shifted out losing his path as well as all the momentum coming to the furlong pole and could not recover to play a role late. SCOTTIE'S BARN settled on the inside in midfield, was hard ridden but was going backwards at the five sixteenths pole, angled out to the five path in upper stretch but failed to be a menace in the late running. CHANCHITO argued for the lead in the three path down the back straight, could not keep up with the lead group giving way three wide midturn, shifted to the four path turning for home but tired between horses in the final furlong. MR. PERFECT was bumped on the outside on the start, recovered to be in the mix up top four deep in the early going, bid for the front end outside going four wide in midturn, shifted to the five path between runners in with a chance at the top of the stretch but faltered in the final furlong.
